**Abstract:** This article examines a case report involving a 34-year-old Asian woman suffering from lower abdominal pain and was found to have a 2-litre haemoperitoneum and a ruptured right ampullary ectopic pregnancy following a laparotomy. It states that with the increasing incidence of ectopic pregnancy, it is important to have a high index of suspicion and to use clinical judgment as well as laboratory investigations in making a diagnosis.
